

## The Required Documents for International Students Applying to a Postgraduate Program in the University of Jordan

For those applying to study at the University of Jordan:

Welcome to the University of Jordan! Once you've selected the specific program you wish to pursue, as an applicant, you are required to input your information directly into the application form found on the Graduate Study School's portal (<https://eservices.ju.edu.jo/highschool/>).

**The student's application must include the following documents compiled into a single PDF file**

(with a size of less than 6 MB):

1. A copy of the General Secondary Certificate (high school or Tawjihi).
2. A copy of the bachelor's degree.
3. For doctoral students, a copy of the master's degree with a rating of at least **Good**.
4. Transcripts for all academic years of both the bachelor's and master's degrees.
5. The grading system used by the student's university (for graduates of non-Jordanian universities).
6. A personal photograph.
7. A copy of the passport.
8. The application fee of US \$150, which is non-refundable.

Upon initial acceptance into the program:

When applicants proceed to complete their registration procedures for the program, they must have their documents certified by the relevant ministries as detailed below:

1. The General Secondary Certificate (high school or Tawjihi) from the Ministry of Education and from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the applicant's home country and in Jordan.
2. The university degree and transcripts from the Ministry of Education and from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the applicant's home country and in Jordan, using this link (<https://rceapp.mohe.gov.jo/>)\*.
3. A no-objection letter from the cultural attaché of the student's country\*\*.
4. Documentation confirming that the student has undergone an English language test. Please refer to the following link for a list of language tests, their required scores, and additional details (<https://graduatestudies.ju.edu.jo/Admissions/Required%20Scores%20of%20English%20Language%20Test.pdf>).
5. A letter from the applicant's embassy or from the Ministry of Higher Education in Jordan confirming recognition of the university where the student studied. To verify if the university is recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education in Jordan, please use this link (<https://rnji.mohe.gov.jo/>).

Please note:

\*There is an office for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs within the Ministry of Education and Scientific Research for certifying documents.

\*\*Kuwaiti applicants must provide the specified document with their application.

\*\*\*Students from English-speaking countries are not required to take a language test.
